Recommendations

Knowledge management:

PSC05/KM01: Further to recommendation PSC04/KM04 on regularizing a comprehensive regional analysis report, IGAD & Partners to implement the recommendations of the IGAD & Partners' Experts meeting

PSC05/KM02: To build synergies and avoid duplication in activities such as 3WMaps, Geo-portal and spatial planning, DI-Monitoring, & IGAD linfo, Document Management System and other web-based knowledge platforms and tools, emphasis should be put on supporting on-going efforts rather than starting new ones.

Capacity building and institutional development:

PSC05/CB01: The SC welcomes Tulane University's Leadership Training Programme as an enrichment of the broader effort to design and implement a Regional Capacity Development Programme for resilience strengthening in IGAD-Region. The Tulane University's Disaster Resilience Leadership Academy will join efforts with IGAD and search for strategic partnerships with other actors working in the field of capacity development to expedite the implementation of the proposed Resilience leadership training programme in partnership with stakeholders from MSs, collectively enhance the capacities of IGAD and IGAD's Member States in the management, coordination and implementation of IDDRSI.

Programming and M&E:

PSC05/ProME01: IGAD to develop clear guidance on the reporting of the progress made in the implementation of IDDRSI activities and PSC recommendations by MS, development partners and other stakeholders involved in the implementation of IDDRSI

PSC05/ProME02: IGAD to undertake a mid-term review of the IDDRSI strategy and make recommendations on the IDDRSI implementation coordination mechanism.

PSC05/ProME03: Further to recommendation PSC03/ProME06 from the 3rd IDDRSI PSC, IGAD & Partners to strengthen the involve the private sector & NGO/CSOs, Pastoral & Farmers groups, and Youth in IDDRSI programming and implementation

PSC05/ProME04: IGAD, MSs & Partners to operationalize and strengthen the IDDRSI national coordination mechanisms linking the National Coordinator, project Managers, IDDRSI focal person and PCU

PSC05/ProME05: IGAD, MSs & Partners to expedite the implementation of agreed proposals high lighting the problem of migration in the context of vulnerability and resilience

Resource Mobilization:

PSC05/RM01: MS, IGAD & DP should endeavour to facilitate the newly recruited National IDDRSI Coordinators and maximize their contribution to the implementation of IDDRSI

Coordination & Partnerships:

PSC05/CoPa01: Develop a clear action plan for the implementation of the Gender and Resilience Working Group (GRWG) and Communities of Practice (CoP)

PSC05/CoPa02: Support gender mainstreaming with the planning, implementation and monitoring and evaluation of the MS Country Programming Paper

PSC05/CoPa03: IGAD to circulate the PSC provisional agenda at least 10 days before to enable member of the committee to make suggestions/inputs
