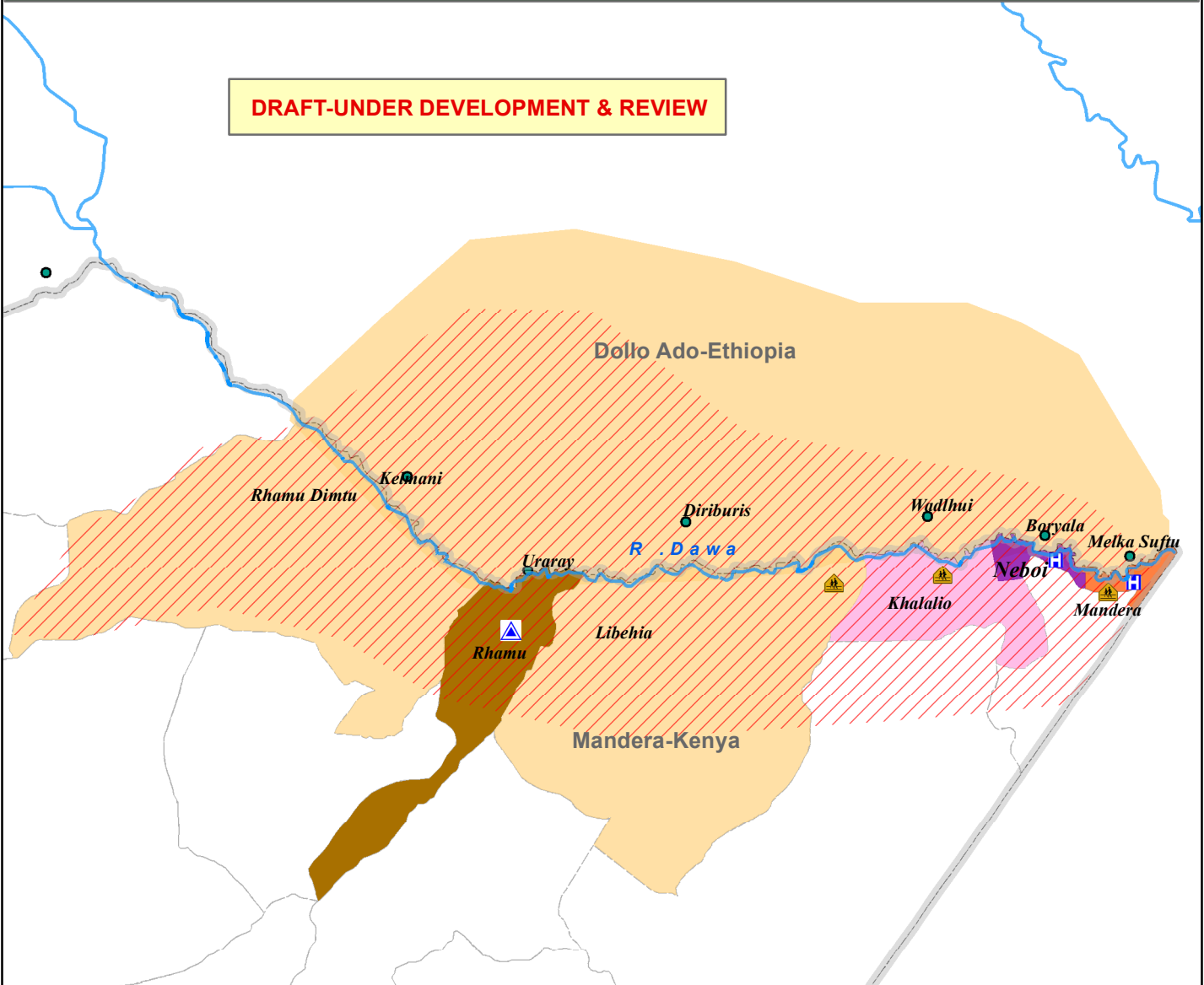


**CLUSTER 3: CONFLICT SUB SYSTEM INVOLVING THE MURURLE-DEGODIYA AND GARRE COMMUNITIES**

**DRAFT-UNDER DEVELOPMENT & REVIEW**



Predominantly Degodiya with other ethnicities including; Muruley, Garre and minority contreme. Major conflict occurs between muruley vs the degodiya and degodiya vs the Garre. Types of conflict include natural resources conflicts (water and pasture), politically and socially instigated conflicts. Political conflicts are heightened during election time in Kenya. Socially instigated conflicts are in relation to gender based violence mainly due to forced marriages and mockeries during cultural festivities that usually turn violent. Revenge attacks are a common occurrence after incidents that involve individuals or house holds of varying ethnicities. Cross border movements are common by youth in search for jobs and has often resulted in violence. NRC competitions occur during the rain season and in prolonged dry seasons. Land claims between Degodiya and Garre has previously led to very high intensity conflicts. Shared resources include Schools, hospitals and health posts in Kenya that are used by all the communities. Conflict Indicators include; unusual movements and migrations, meetings rumors prolonged droughts and Kenya elections. The drying of the Dawa river usually marks the onset of raids. A profound lack of cash usually triggers raids.
